The Victorian mansion "Feldemore", now Belmont School, is located to the east of the village of Holmbury St Mary, standing high on the hill towards Abinger. Built in the late 19th century and once owned by the Waterhouse family of Price Waterhouse fame, this fine Arts and Crafts building houses the work of William Morris and William de Morgan.

On Saturday, 5 December, there will be a guided walk exploring more of the Surrey Hills adjoining Belmont School, followed by mulled wine and mince pies in the School Hall by kind invitation of the Headmistress.

Make the Surrey Hills part of your Christmas celebrations with this fun and social event.

You will need stout walking shoes and be fit enough to climb small hills. Dogs are welcome. The event may not be suitable for members with mobility difficulties. Bring wet weather gear if rain is forecast.
